PART A (PAPER)

SECTION 1 (25 MARKS)

Development of good voice and speech in young learners with special reference to Speech from Grade 1 – 8 of the CALSDA syllabus.

SECTION 2 (25 MARKS)

Development of good performing skills in reading, poetry and prose in advanced learners.

SECTION 3 (25 MARKS)

Development and the use of mime and improvisation and performing skills in Drama.

SECTION 4 (25 MARKS)

Importance of Drama for advanced learners. (Use of Drama in the classroom)

PART B (PRACTICAL)

SECTION 1 (20 MARKS)

To perform a dramatic extract.

SECTION 2 (20 MARKS)

To perform a narrative prose or poem by memory

SECTION 3 (20 MARKS)

To perform from memory a lyric poem.
(The performance of items for sections 1, 2 and 3 should not take longer than twenty minutes)

SECTION 4 (20 MARKS)

To present a study journal with teaching material suitable from Grade 4 - 8 of Speech and Drama.

SECTION 5 (20 MARKS)

To read a passage of verse or prose provided by the examiner.
To discuss the preparation of their chosen extracts as well as show knowledge of all the aspects of theory of speech from Grades 2 – 8 of the Speech and Drama Syllabus.
