To recite a narrative poem by memory

(The performance of items for sections 1, 2 and 3 should not take longer than fifteen minutes)

SECTION 4 (20 MARKS)

To present a study journal with teaching material suitable for Introductory to Grade 3 of Speech and Drama.

SECTION 5 (20 MARKS)

To discuss the preparation of their chosen extracts as well as show knowledge of the following aspects of theory of speech.

Pausing, Phrasing, Emphasis, Pitch, Pace, Power, Relaxation, Posture, Inflection and Modulation.
